Why enrol for these skills programmes?

By way of introduction

It is a well known fact that educators are now required to develop themselves in order to enhance their professional competence and performance in the classroom and school. The concept of CPTD (Continued Professional Teacher Development) for teachers is a crucial topic in the new National Policy Framework for Teacher Education and Development in South Africa. This policy was gazetted at the end of April 2007 and it thus becomes an educator's responsibility to identify development needs and address these through appropriate training.

What does the educator stand to gain?

According to the policy, the educator will benefit by "greater professional confidence, enhanced knowledge, better understanding and improved teaching and class management". In addition, teachers may achieve their required periodic PD (professional development) points, thus making themselves more competitive for performance recognition and promotion.

Education Management and Leadership Skills Programmes

The skills programmes offered by Edutel will achieve exactly what is required of you as an educator. Apart from developing yourself as an educator and giving yourself a better chance for promotion, you will be achieving the following:

- upon declaration of competence against a skills programme, you will be awarded the relevant number of credits for the programme;
- your name will be logged on the National Learner Records Database as a lifelong learner;
- you will be accumulating credits (equivalent to the first year) towards a higher education qualification, namely ACE Education (School Management and Leadership); SAQA ID 48878
- you should be accumulating your PD points for the first three year cycle which should start very soon;
- you will be able to complete your second year for ACE School Management and Leadership with the University of Johannesburg.

Purpose of the qualification:

Each one of these skills programmes is SAQA and NQF aligned and have been approved by the Quality Assurance division of the Education Training and Development SETA. You will thus be working with excellent, outcomes-based programmes which will allow you to develop competencies right there in the school. You have nothing to lose if you start now: be ahead when the rush for PD points begins! Work towards your ACE: School Management and Leadership.

Rules relating to assessment, academic credit, progression and qualification

NO EXAMS!! Learners will be assessed by writing knowledge questionnaire and compiling Portfolios of Evidence. Once you are declared competent and your assessment outcomes have been verified by the ETDP SETA you will earn the credits linked to the unit standards making up your skills programme.

These credits will be registered on the National Learner Records Database and will remain to your credit always. Should you want to continue with your studies, you will be able to apply for RPL/credits for what you have already achieved - if it forms part of that qualifications' curriculum. This skills programme/qualification will serve as an entry requirement for follow-up skills programmes/qualifications specialising in the same field at a higher level. The four unit standards listed in this pamphlet will grant you entrance to the second year ACE School Management and Leadership with the University of Johannesburg.

Where and when do I write my knowledge questionnaires?

This will be written when you attend contact sessions.

When can I start?

Any time throughout the year.

Will I attend any classes?

Contact classes will be arranged during the course of the year during school holidays at major centres in January, April and July. You choose when you want to attend. If you are registered before 30 October you can attend in January. If are registered before 30 January you can attend in April and if you are registered before 15 May you can attend in July.

Do I have to buy extra books?

No, all material will be provided.

To which qualification can these unit standards lead?

Advanced Certificate: Education (School Management and Leadership)

With whom can I complete my Qualification should I so choose?

Learners can apply for RPL with any University offering the Advanced Certificate: Education (School Management and Leadership, ID 48878).

The University of Johannesburg will give you credits for the first year leaving you with only the second year to complete.

Added advantage

These unit standards are written in outcomes-based format, are competency-based and are fully in line with the now 70/30 approach - 30% Instructional learning, 70% Application.

Workplace learning

Learners receive a workplace assessment guide addressed to the senior at school to assist you with the necessary mentoring and workplace exposure.
